Abby S.- "My favorite camp memory was the first day I was a LT at circus/flying trapeze because I immediately knew that I wanted to be a counselor in those activities!"

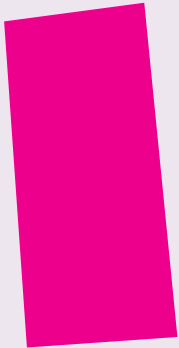




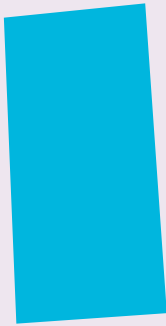

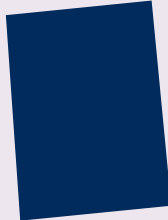
