Basketball Pavilion

Ever since we built the Lindendome most of our basketball activities have taken place there since it is covered and protects the court from both the rain and sun. We wanted to give one of our most popular sports more room for their periods and providing more covered space for other activities. We are going to be replacing the lower basketball courts with brand new courts, basketball hoops, bleachers, score board, AND putting a new pavilion over the entire thing!! This is going to give us a new 8000 square foot basketball complex for everyone to enjoy!! It is going to be connected to the circus pavilion as well giving that area additional coverage. There will be a porch area connecting the two together.
